



## Acrylic Paint

- A rainbow of professional-quality acrylics, including neutral colours.

## Acrylic Mediums

- Acrylic Polymer or Gell Medium.
- tip: Matte mediums are best for mixed media, Gloss mediums are best for clarity of colour and collage.
- Acrylic Texture Mediums (optional).

## Brushes

- A variety of paint brushes for acrylics. Make sure you have a selection of small, medium, and large.
- Palette knives and other utensils to push paint around and make marks.

## Surfaces

- Heavy-weight watercolour or mixed media paper ie. a large sheet you can cut down, or a 9"x12" pad for exercises
- 2-3 surfaces, type and size of your choice! A birch wood panel or watercolour paper is recommended for those wishing to push mixed media (drawing & painting) possibilities.

## Other

- A range of dry media, anything that can make a mark, ie: charcoal pencils/sticks, graphite pencils/sticks, coloured pencils, wax crayons, Conte, china markers, oil pastels, soft pastels, water-soluble graphite, water-soluble pencil crayons, litho crayons, markers, ballpoint pens, permanent markers/fineliners, oil pastels, paint markers, etc. Please bring a selection of items you already have.
- Collage elements ie. glitter, gold leaf, washi, magazine pages (optional)
- sketchbook, pencil/pen
- old rags or paper towels
- acrylic paint palette (non-stick preferred)
- reference photos that inspire you. The instructor will also provide references.
