Materials List for Imaginative Illustration with Gouache Nazrin Alaskarov



- Sketchbook of any size for ideas and drawing
- 2B or HB pencil for sketching
- Eraser
- Sharpener
- Any painting pad with thick paper, 9x12 in (ex. Strathmore Watercolour Pad)
- Gouache set (ex. Holbein Artists Gouache 5 Set or 5 individual paints
 - o Titanium White
 - o Pure Red
 - o Primary Yellow
 - o Primary Cyan
 - o Black
- Palette Paper
- Brushes (any set would do but I highly recommend at least a single thin round brush for details and a flat medium size brush)
- Painters Tape

** Gouache can imitate both watercolour or acrylic depending on the type that is used, as it can be transparent or opaque. One of the unique properties of gouache is that it has a very matte finish and it is fairly resistant to fading. I personally use the <u>Turner acrylic gouache</u> (Amazon)
