Job Description

Visual Arts Mississauga (VAM) is hiring Visual Art Instructors to teach Summer Art Camp! From June -August, Summer Camp Art Instructors will work alongside teen volunteers to create a fun, safe and creative visual art experience for children age 6-13 years old. Art Instructors will teach various visual art projects along 4 themes, lead games and activities while supervising a group of up to 16 children per day in an art studio setting.

The ideal Art Instructor candidate will be engaging, with excellent communication skills and the ability to develop a good rapport with students and parents. They will have strong facilitation techniques, be organized, resourceful and have great problem-solving abilities. The Instructor will represent VAM in a professional manner with a focus on safety and customer service. Camp Instructors are required to have a full-time, weekday availability from June 18- August 23rd.



A post-secondary education in Visual Arts or Education is preferred with experience working in various media including watercolour, acrylic, pastel, collage, dry media and printmaking as well as a basic knowledge of art fundamental or art history. We are looking for strong leaders with the ability to work both independently and collaboratively as part of a team.

This position requires the candidate to teach in-person to school groups and onsite to campers. Paid training will be provided.

Camp Instructors are responsible for the following:

- Collaborate in the development of art project samples and ensure you have a thorough knowledge of each assigned Summer Camp project
- · Organize, prepare and maintain studios, art supplies and materials
- Instruct and manage groups of 16 students age 6-13 in art studios and common spaces from 9:00 am 4:30 pm daily
- Mentor and manage student volunteers in and out of the art studios
- · Maintain a safe and inclusive camp environment for 76 campers per week
- · Supervise campers when playing outdoors, ensuring they stay in designated areas
- · Communicate with Camp Coordinator and fellow instructors daily
- Provide a Vulnerable Sector Search
- · Provide a current First Aid Certificate (or be willing to obtain)
- · Complete the High Five Principles of Healthy Child Development

Required Skills or Training

- · Ability and proven experience working with and engaging groups of children
- Education and/or experience working in various media including, watercolour, acrylics, pastel, collage, printmaking etc. Experience working with clay or digital media an asset.
- · Excellent communication skills and good rapport with children



- Strong leadership and organizational skills along with ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Good problem-solving skills, versatility
- · Must be energetic, organized, hard-working and willing to work as part of a dynamic team
- · Must provide a valid Police Vulnerable Sector Search
- · Current first aid certificate, or willingness to obtain prior to the beginning of camp
- Demonstrate excellent customer service skills when communicating with parents and the public.
