In this role, you'll research and design art lesson plans for K–12 learners that reflect Indigenous ways of knowing, and help test and deliver workshops with teens, supporting participants through creative projects and leadership activities.

This is a hands-on opportunity to build experience in curriculum development, teaching, and youth mentorship within a supportive arts environment.

- Interest in art education, Indigenous learning, or youth programming
- Strong communication and organizational skills
- Creativity and willingness to learn
- Preference will be given to candidates who identify as Indigenous or who have a strong background in Indigenous art history

**Eligibility:** Applicants must meet Canada Summer Jobs criteria (ages 15–30, eligible to work in Canada).

We strongly encourage Indigenous applicants to apply and invite those who wish to do so to self-identify in their cover letter. As an organization, VAM is working towards reconciliation goals by recognizing and sharing the rich cultural contributions of Indigenous peoples through visual art and education.
